This statement is to say something about your overall work. It must be at least one paragraph, but no more than a page. I recommend adding this to your portfolio however you would like. Try not to be super transparent with this, leave the reader guessing and craving more after they read it, but not so much that they might feel confused. You are sharing a deep piece of you, and everyone looks for human connection to artwork. Whether that be for you, or for others, humans are social and emotional beings.  Things to think about when approaching YOUR artist statement:  1. What ideas/concepts did you explore OR what about the clay process drives you? 2. What should the viewer take away from your work while looking at? 3. This is not a "I liked this project the best, or I liked this project the least" statement. 4. What drives you creatively? 5. If you are into functional, what about the forms excite you to create the way you do? Such as the feel and interaction physically with a piece, and does that have or need a emotional connection for you as the creator?
